

### E. Cleveland Marks Golden Date Monday

A two-month celebration of East Cleveland's golden anniversary as a city starts Monday. Features will include a time capsule, an anniversary queen, an outdoor art show and a civic dinner.

The Kiwanis Club will unveil a "time capsule" of stainless steel at ceremonies on the opening day. The capsule will be filled with items representing all facets of community life and cemented into place in the City Hall.

Fifty years later it is to be opened by a member of the current Shaw High School student body.

The anniversary queen will be chosen at a dinner in the YMCA next Tuesday night. The Exchange Club is sponsor.

An outdoor art show on Hayden Avenue between Hartford Road and Milan Avenue will be Sept. 30 and Oct. 1.

The display will include paintings, sculpture, woodcarving, ceramics and silversmithing. It is sponsored by the Arts Exhibitors Association, with headquarters in East Cleveland.

Climax of the celebration is Oct. 28 when a testimonial dinner will be given at Shaw High for City Manager Charles A. Carran.

### School Driving Courses Urged in Absence of Pros

Where there are no private professional driver education schools, high schools should retain driver education programs. That stand was taken yesterday by the National Professional Driver Education Association at its final session in Hotel Statler-Hilton.

A more positive attitude toward highway safety than the negative slogan of "speed kills" was urged. Instead of a fatalistic attitude, more common safety precautions should be publicized, the resolution said.

The organization also favored the "lights on" program that calls for motorists to keep their headlights on during holiday driving as a safety reminder.
